On Shabbat, I pour wine into my kiddush cup.

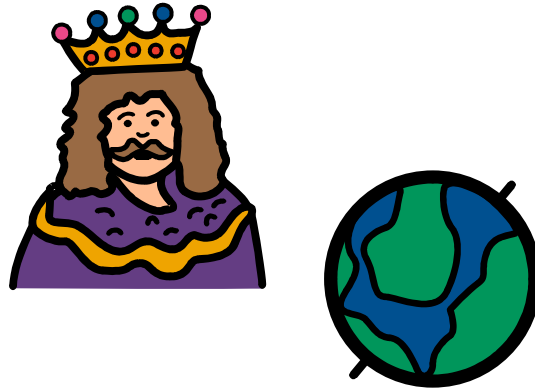
